Sample Itinerary:

MON 4pm **Arrive & Check in:** If you wish to arrive early, please feel free to enjoy our leisure facilities including swimming pool, sauna, steam, spa and gym.

6pm **Welcome meeting:** To discuss facilities & your itinerary.

TUE 10am **Fairhaven Golf Club:** 18 holes & lunch
This is a relatively unsung course compared to some of its more illustrious neighbours but is definitely a championship quality venue. Fairhaven is what its name suggests - there are no gimmicky or trick holes here - but at the same time it will test every department of any golfer's game. That's why it has hosted many prestigious tournaments since it was opened in 1923, including Open Qualifying when the Open Championship is held at nearby Royal Lytham & St. Annes. It has also received the accolade of being named one of "The Best 10 'Open Championship' Qualifying Courses" in a leading UK golf magazine.

WED 10am **St Annes Old Links Golf Club:** 18 holes & lunch
Another true seaside links course, this course has also been used as the venue for qualifying rounds for The Open Championship. The course was laid out by Alex Herd, winner of The Open Championship in 1902, and is next to the sand dunes, which overlook the Irish Sea, so the wind is a factor on most days.

THURS 10am **Royal Lytham & St Annes:** 18 holes & lunch
The Royal Lytham and St. Annes Golf Course is one of the most unique courses in the rotation of the British Open. It is a links in every sense of the word, with sandy soil and the wind blowing in from the Irish Sea. The course is well designed, with holes to test every level of player and has played host to no less than ten Open Championships, two Ryder Cups and numerous other major tournaments including the Women's and Seniors Open Championships.
