Section 10 – Tax Free Childcare
<p><i>We accept both Tax-Free Childcare and Universal Credit Childcare.</i></p> <p><i>Families using Tax-Free Childcare can make payments directly to the setting through their online childcare account. The government adds 20p for every 80p parents pay in, giving families up to £2,000 per child per year towards childcare costs. Once your account is set up, you simply search for our setting by name and pay your childcare fees from your Tax-Free Childcare account instead of your regular bank account.</i></p> <p><i>Families claiming Universal Credit Childcare pay their childcare fees to us in the usual way, then submit their invoices and payment receipts to Universal Credit as proof of payment. The Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) can then reimburse up to 85% of eligible childcare costs, depending on your circumstances.</i></p> <p><i>We're always happy to support families using either scheme and can provide invoices or receipts as needed to help with claims.</i></p>
